

Applying Advance Adhesion Knowledge to Achieve Esthetic and Predictable Direct Anterior and Posterior Composites Restorations, including Rehabilitation

The goal of a responsible clinician is to provide his or her patients with functional, long lasting, and esthetically pleasing anterior and posterior restorations, in the most conservative and bio-compatible fashion; direct composites can be technique sensitive, difficult, time consuming and often financially unrewarding procedures; this may, in large part, be due to the incorrect use of new materials. Some of the new material require a completely new approach, if we are going to be successful with them. Dr. Ruiz presents a completely new, scientifically based, approach to tooth preparation and restoration of the most widely performed procedures in dentistry direct composites, using supra- gingival principles.

Dr. Ruiz will review the latest knowledge in advance adhesion, techniques, materials, and will review the principles necessary to perform exquisite, predictable and simple, direct anterior and posterior composite restorations, including rehabilitation with direct composite.

Learning Objective

- Describe new preparation techniques which maximize success and minimize complications, using supra- gingival principles
- Describe a predictable and simple technique for placing composite, with ideal marginal seal, managing the effects of polymerization shrinkage
- Identify the different composite resins and bonding systems by category and describe when and how to use them.
- Identify the principle of form, texture, color and the use of stains to perform beautiful composite restorations.
- Fully understand adhesives (bonding systems) and how to be successful with them.
- Describe the different matrix, wedge, and ring system and when to use them.
- Identify the principle of smile design necessary to perform beautiful composite veneers and much more...

About the Speaker

Dr. Ruiz is founder of the "Supra- gingival Minimally Invasive Dentistry" movement, as well as founder and director of the **Los Angeles Institute of Clinical Dentistry**. Former Course Director of numerous CE Courses at the University of Southern California (**USC**). He is an Honorary Clinical Professor at **Warrick University in England** and a member of the editorial board for **Dentistry Today**. He is also an Associate Instructor at Dr. Gordan **Christensen PCC** in Utah & an independent evaluator of dental products for **CR (CRA)**. **Dr. Ruiz has been named as one of the "Leaders in CE 2006-Present" by Dentistry Today**.

Dr. Ruiz is the author of the textbook "Supra- gingival Minimally Invasive Dentistry; A Healthier Approach" published by Wiley-Blackwell and edited by Dr. Ray Bertolotti and has also published **several research papers** as well as many clinical articles on adhesive dentistry, occlusion and esthetic dentistry. He regularly **lectures at all major dental meetings, nationally and internationally**.

Dr. Ruiz has been practicing in the studio district of Los Angeles for over 25 years and enjoys a clientele of many stars and entertainers. His focus is on treating complex Cosmetic, Rehabilitation, and Implant cases.

Finally, Juan F. completed a residency program and a master in pediatric dentistry at the University of Kentucky in 2012.

Juan F. is board-certified by the American Boards of Pediatric Dentistry, Oral Medicine, and Dental Public Health. He is an active member of the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry, American Academy of Oral Medicine, American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology, Indiana Dental Association, and American Dental Association. Juan F. is a fellow in dental surgery from the Royal College of Surgeons at Edinburgh. He is a member of the editorial board of Oral Surgery, Oral Medicine, Oral Pathology, and Oral Radiology. 

Course Description & Objectives

Dentoalveolar Trauma:

This lecture will discuss vital pulp therapy on immature permanent teeth, cracked teeth, various injuries to permanent teeth including the management and treatment of these injuries. Furthermore, we will discuss the long-term consequences of dental traumatic injuries.

Prevention and Treatment of Procedural Accidents in Endodontics:

This lecture will discuss file separation, perforations, transportation, and other endodontic mishaps. In addition, we will discuss techniques to prevent endodontic accidents from occurring, and provide the current treatment options needed to remedy these misfortunes.

About the Speaker

Dr. Paul Sahni graduated summa cum laude from the University of Evansville in 1997 with a double major in biology and chemistry. He then attended Southern Illinois University School of Dental Medicine, where he earned his Doctorate of Dental Medicine (DMD) in 2001. During his time there he was inducted into the dental honor society Omicron Kappa Upsilon.

After dental school DR. Sahni completed his General Practice Residency (GPR) at Indiana University Hospital. Following the completion of his GPR, Dr. Sahni served his endodontic residency at Indiana University and the VA Medical Center in Indianapolis, Indiana. In 2004 he received his certificate in endodontics along with a Master's Degree in Dentistry. (MSD)

Dr. Sahni has been on staff as an adjunct professor in the Graduate Endodontic Department at Indiana University School of Dentistry since 2004. There he is a member on the admission's committee for the incoming endodontic residents and plays an active role in the clinical and academic education of the current endodontic residents.

Dr. Sahni has been published in the Journal of Endodontics and General Dentistry Journal. He is a licensed endodontist in the states of Illinois and Indiana, and a member of the American Association of Endodontics (AAE), American Dental Association (ADA), Illinois State Dental Society (ISDS), Illini Dental Society (IDDS), and Omicron Kappa Upsilon (OKU). He has maintained a private practice in Champaign, Illinois for over 20 years.
